1. As authorized by the Judicial Conference of the United States, the United States District Court for the Northern District of Alabama sets the following rates for transcripts by Official Court Reporters:

1 A real time "feed" is the electronic data flow from the court reporter to the computer of each person or party ordering and receiving the realtime transcription in the courtroom.

Note: Orders placed on or before the day of the proceeding will be batched together for purposes of determining the number of feeds, and subsequent orders will be charged at the lowest page rate assessed on the previous orders.

- 2. Pursuant to 28 U.S.C. § 753(f), no fee shall be charged for a copy of a transcript delivered to the clerk for the records of the court.
- 3. These rates are effective for all transcript orders received on or after November 1, 2024. Transcripts ordered prior to the effective date of these new rates should be billed at the rates in effect at the time the order was placed.
